

## MENTOR PROGRAM

East Chambers ISD implemented several new strategies to increase student academic achievement in 2006-2007, one of which is a mentoring program for students who were unsuccessful on one or more TAKS or SDAAIL tests taken last year. Because we believe all children can be successful on each test attempted this year, we will be offering additional assistance to reach the passing goal. One or more staff members will be assigned students during the course of this school year to serve in this mentoring capacity.

Mentors will provide:

1. Extra tutoring and support.
2. Monitor your child's daily routine, attendance, grades, classroom behavior, and homework.
3. Contact you occasionally to provide you with feedback about how your child is progressing to reach mastery of the objectives.
4. Coordinate scheduling for extra tutoring.
5. Positive incentives to increase motivation to help keep your child stay on target.
